- **COVID-19**
 - Health Care Worker Vaccine Requirement - CDPH order issued on August 5, 2021, requires everyone who works in a health care facility to be vaccinated against COVID-19. Workers must have received their final dose of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine series or the single dose of a one-dose COVID-19 vaccine by September 30, 2021. Exemptions from the vaccine requirement are permitted only for religious beliefs or qualifying medical conditions. ([full order online here](#))
 - Requirement for Visitors in Acute Health and Long-Term Care Settings- CDPH amended order of August 5, 2021 requires, unvaccinated or partially vaccinated visitors to be eligible for indoor visits only if they can show documentation of a negative SARS-CoV-2 test where the specimen collection occurred within 72 hours before each visit and for which the test results are available at the time of entry to the facility.
